



Dyer Prince Road Salt Marsh Restoration Project- Eastham, MA

Massachusetts Division of Ecological Restoration (DER)

The Dyer Prince Road salt marsh is located in Eastham, Massachusetts. The road separates the subject marsh from Rock Harbor Creek and restricts its tidal exchange with the creek. Under a Technical Master Service Agreement with the Division of Ecological Restoration (DER), HW has provided the following services in support of this salt marsh restoration project:

- Conducted a topographical site survey;
- Delineated wetland resource areas within the immediate project vicinity;
- Conducted a low-lying property survey;
- Evaluated tidal data to assess the extent of tidal restriction posed by the existing culvert; and
- Conducted hydrodynamic modeling to evaluate potential culvert replacement options.

Forthcoming project activities under this contract will likely include:

- Culvert replacement design and permitting; and
- Construction administration of the selected restoration plan.
