



Burrillville Bicycle and Pedestrian Path

Town of Burrillville, Rhode Island

The Burrillville Bicycle and Walking Trail is a multi-modal public path that will provide a safe pedestrian connection between the villages of Harrisville and Pascoag in Burrillville, Rhode Island. The multi-modal path will be constructed within 6,200 feet of abandoned railroad right of way which connects Mowry Street in Harrisville to East Street in Pascoag. The amenity will provide two-lane bicycle and pedestrian access through forested undeveloped tracts of land, residential neighborhoods, and freshwater wetlands. The town of Burrillville retained the Horsley Witten Group, Inc. (HW) to provide the following services:

- Community outreach;
- Site surveying, including topography and wetland delineation;
- Civil engineering for culvert analysis, stormwater management and final design;
- Landscape architecture design;
- Hazardous waste remediation planning and permitting;
- Wetland impact permitting; and
- Local land development permitting.

Other public safety and drainage improvements designed by HW include: sidewalks, curbing, wood guardrail, roadway and walkway striping, signage, American Disabilities Act (ADA) compliance, benches, fencing, and landscape plantings.
