

Implementing an Energy Efficiency and Conservation Strategy (EECS) for the City of Attleboro

City of Attleboro

The Horsley Witten Group, Inc. (HW), in partnership with Gaskell Associates, is providing technical assistance to the City of Attleboro to implement the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Strategy (EECS), developed under the City's EEC Block Grant allocation. The Project Team is working with Attleboro's Department of Planning and Development to identify, design, and implement energy efficiency retrofit projects and traffic LED retrofit projects.

The Project includes a comprehensive compilation and review of the City's energy use information to identify consumption and cost trends; benchmark relative energy use and building performance; and establish an initial consumption baseline. Using data from the energy utilities and coordinating energy audits, as needed, the Team will work with the City to develop a list of targeted energy efficiency measures to consider for implementation and/or audit.

The Project Team will prioritize retrofit projects that can most likely be completed as part of this EECBG allocation; however, the Project Team will also identify other longer term energy efficiency retrofit projects that may be implemented in the future.

Our Team will also ensure that the goals and commitments identified in the EECS are completed on time and within budget. We will also identify and prioritize additional opportunities for municipal energy reduction beyond the near-term retrofits identified.

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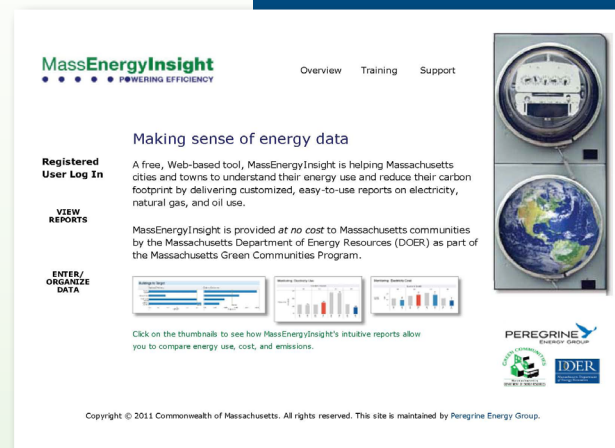
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
